

| Tirana Art Fest | A competition for young people from all high schools in Tirana, featuring multiple genres. | February- June | Tirana |
| Fem Fest | Exhibitions, speeches, theatre, and many other activities for the rights of women. | 8 March | Tirana |
| Summer Day | Diverse activities around the city, including games, music, agricultural and retro fairs, exhibitions, and evening concerts with national artists. | 14 March | Various locations in Tirana |
| Eid al-Fitr | Collective prayer in the city center. | 30 March | Skanderbeg Square |
| Marie Kraja International Opera Festival | A prestigious event celebrating global operatic talent, providing a platform for emerging opera singers. | March | National Theater of Opera and Ballet |
| International Day of Sites and Monuments | Promotion of cultural heritage in Tirana through various activities. | 18 April | Tirana |



| Bio Meat Fest | A celebration of archaeology, recreation, nature, and agribusiness. Highlights include the Old Graves of Vrap, the lakes of Mustafa Kocaj and Roves, and the waterfalls of Vrap and Askolaj Rock. | Baldushk |
| Cave Fest | A recreational and nature-focused event featuring landmarks such as Pellumbas Cave and the canyons of Erzeni. | Berzhite |
| Dajti N'Fest | A recreational, natural, and agribusiness event showcasing landmarks like the Castle of Tujan, the Castle of Dajt, the Church of Saint Mary, the National Park of Dajt, and Saint Mary's Cave. | Dajt |
| Adventure Fest, Farka N'Fest | This event highlights recreation, nature, and agribusiness. Notable landmarks include the Castle of Tujan, the Castle of Dajt, the Church of Saint Mary, the National Park of Dajt, and Saint Mary's Cave. | Farke |
